

# UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.



Be it Remembered, That at a COURT OF COMMON PLEAS, held at New Brunswick, for the County of Middlesex, in the State of New Jersey, in the United States of America, on the *Third* day of *November* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty *one*

*Michael O'Reilly* a native of *Ireland* exhibited a petition, praying to be admitted to become a Citizen of the

United States, and it appearing to the said Court that he had declared on Oath, before the Clerk of the Court of

*Common Pleas for Middlesex County, N. J.* on the *29* day of *October* A. D. 18*81*, that

it was *bona fide* his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the *Queen of*

*Great Britain & Ireland* of whom he was at that time a subject, and the said

*Michael O'Reilly* having on his solemn Oath declared, and also made proof

thereof by competent testimony of *Thomas Ferry*

a Citizen of the United States, that he had resided one year and upwards within the State of New Jersey, and within

the United States of America upwards of five years immediately preceding his application; and it appearing to

the satisfaction of the Court that during that time he had behaved as a man of good moral character, attached

to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness

of the same; and having on his solemn Oath declared before the said Court, that he would support the Constitu-

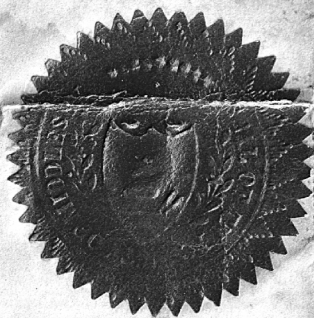
tion of the United States, and that he did absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity

to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State and Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the *Queen of Great*

*Britain & Ireland* of whom he was before a subject. Thereupon the Court admitted the said

*Michael O'Reilly* to become a Citizen of the United States, and ordered all the proceedings aforesaid to be recorded by the Clerk of

the said Court; and which was done accordingly.
